**Brandeis Lecturer**



Sally Warner is an Associate Professor of Climate Science at Brandeis University. As a physical oceanographer, her research focuses on how water moves and mixes in the ocean. Most recently, she worked with a team of oceanographers and glaciologists at the LeConte Glacier in Alaska to study the ocean's role in accelerating the rate of glacier melt. At Brandeis, Professor Warner teaches oceanography, climate science and historical geology, covering topics like Southern Ocean currents, Antarctic glacier melt, ice cores for paleo-climate study and fossils' role in understanding plate tectonics. She holds a PhD in physical oceanography from the University of Washington and a BEng in mechanical engineering from McGill University.
