Eva Bellin is the Myra and Robert Kraft Professor of Arab Politics at Brandeis University, affiliated with the Department of Politics and the Crown Center for Middle East Studies. A comparativist, her research focuses on democratization. authoritarian persistence, political and economic reform, civil society, religion and politics, and cultural change. At Brandeis, she teaches courses on the Middle East and North Africa, including topics in contemporary Turkish politics and culture. Bellin is the author of Stalled Democracy: Capital, Labor, and the Paradox of State-Sponsored Development and coeditor of Building Rule of Law in the Arab World. She has conducted fieldwork in Tunisia, Egypt, Israel, and Pakistan, and earned her BA from Harvard and PhD from Princeton.



Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Istanbul, Turkey.

Day 2 | Istanbul, Turkey

Day 4 | Istanbul

See the Hippodrome of Constantinople, where Roman chariots once raced, and go down into the atmospheric Basilica Cistern, an underground reservoir. You'll also tour the Hagia Sophia Grand Mosque, a Byzantine gem. During your explorations, stop for lunch in the old town.

Day 5 | Istanbul | Kayseri | Göreme National Park | Cavusin | Ürgüp

Check out this morning and fly to Kayseri. Arrive and transfer to Cappadocia, celebrated for its astounding and otherworldly rocky landscape.

Göreme National Park. Within this captivating open-air museum, step inside small churches that were carved out of the rocks by a former monastic community and decorated with frescoes in the Byzantine period. Later, marvel at Love Valley's whimsical fairy chimneys and charming Cavusin, a village cut into the rocks. Check in to the Yunak Evleri Cave Hotel in Ürgüp. Tonight, gather for drinks and dinner, and watch a lovely sunset over Cappadocia.

Day 6 | Devrent Valley | Ozkonak | Avanos

Elective | Cappadocia Hot Air Balloon Ride. Float over the incredible, multicolored terrain on an unforgettable sunrise journey.

Ozkonak Underground City. Take a guided tour of a subterranean network of chambers.

Avanos Pottery Workshop. Watch skilled potters shape pieces out of the local red clay and learn about their techniques and designs.

Day 7 | Ürgüp | Kayseri | Izmir | Ephesus | Bodrum | Embark gulet

Check out today and travel to Kayseri for your flight to Izmir. Arrive and transfer to Ephesus.

Ephesus. Appreciate the well-preserved remains of this acclaimed ancient city, which was a major trading port for the Greeks and the Romans. During your guided tour, admire the impressive Great Theater that could seat thousands, the grand, second-century Library of Celsus, the Terrace Houses adorned with mosaics and other remarkable ruins.

Day 8 | Cruising | Yaliciftlik | Etrim | Çati Bay

Relish the Turquoise Coast's picture-perfect coastal splendor as the yacht sails to Yaliciftlik. Disembark and travel by motor coach to Etrim.


Etrim. Stroll through this peaceful Anatolian mountain village and learn about enduring traditions like carpet and kilim weaving.


Free Time: Unwind this afternoon as the yacht cruises to Çati Bay, where it will overnight.

Day 9 | Cruising | Cleopatra Island | English Harbor

Cleopatra Island & English Harbor. Delight in these tranquil spots where the yacht drops anchor and enjoy leisure time for snorkeling and other activities on the pristine waters.

Day 10 | Karacasöğüt | Disembark gulet | Dalyan | Dalaman | Istanbul

After breakfast, disembark in Karacasöğüt and transfer to Dalyan. Next, cruise in a small boat along the Dalyan Strait to Kaunos.

From the boat, gaze up at the striking, Grecian-inspired temple tombs cut into the rugged cliffs and then head up to the hilltop for a guided tour of the archaeological ruins of this ancient city. Continue to Dalaman and fly to Istanbul. Upon arrival, check in to the Barceló Istanbul Hotel.

Free Time: Enjoy your final evening in Istanbul.
