Dmitry Troyanovsky '98 is an associate professor of theater arts at Brandeis. Director Troyanovsky stages productions, teaches, leads workshops, and develops new theatrical material at national and international institutions, including the Shanghai Dramatic Arts Center in China, American Repertory Theatre, Opera Idaho, Bard Music Festival, Asolo Repertory Theatre, Baryshnikov Arts Center, Shanghai Theatre Academy, Moscow Art Theatre School, and 92nd Street Y in New York, among other educational institutions. A refugee from the former Soviet Union (now Ukraine), Troyanovsky brings an outsider experience to his work. He is an MFA graduate of the American Repertory Theatre Institute for the Advanced Theatre Training at Harvard University and earned his BA from Brandeis University.


