Assistant Professor of Classical and Early Mediterranean Studies at Brandeis

Eóin's research includes the archaeology and material culture of the ancient Mediterranean, with a focus on pre-and early-Roman Italy and the Punic world. As a field archaeologist, he works on excavations in Sicily and Tuscany during the summer. He excavates at Poggio Civitate, an Etruscan settlement south of Siena, and works with the Pantelleria Project on the excavation of a Punic and Roman sanctuary site on the island of Pantelleria (a small island between Sicily and Tunisia). Professor O'Donoghue is also a book review editor for the "Ancient West & East" journal.





Day 1| In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Valletta, Malta.

Day 2 | Valletta, Malta | Sliema

Upon arrival, transfer **3** to Sliema and check in to the AX The Palace. Tonight, meet your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception and Dinner.

Day 3 | Valletta

Enrichment: History of Malta.

Valletta. Over a history spanning almost 8,000 years, Malta has been ruled by the Phoenicians, Romans, Byzantines, Arabs, the Order of St. John and the British, among others. In 1566, the Knights of the Order of St. John built this magnificent, fortified city between two natural harbors. On a guided walk within this UNESCO World Heritage site, admire stunning views over the Grand Harbor from the Upper Barrakka Gardens. Then, visit Valletta's crown jewel, the St. John's Co-Cathedral, featuring a dazzling interior and Caravaggio's masterpiece, "The Beheading of John the Baptist." Next, tour the elegant Casa Rocca Piccola, a 16th-century noble house. Enjoy lunch at a restaurant later.

Free Time: The rest of the day is yours to plan.

Day 4 | Mdina | Rabat | Hagar Qim

Mdina & Rabat. Largely car-free, Malta's walled ancient capital of Mdina is known as the Silent City. Pass through the regal city gate and stroll along its enchanting lanes to see handsome noble houses and St. Paul's Cathedral. On a walk in nearby Rabat, visit the Domus Romana, a museum on the site of a Roman house. Relish lunch, then set off for the southern coast. **Hagar Qim Temples.** Malta boasts some of the world's oldest free-standing stone buildings, a group of megalithic temples recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Dating from 3600-3200 B.C., these astounding structures were built before the advent of metal tools and the introduction of the wheel. Marvel at the Hagar Qim temple-complex with your guide.

Free Time: Return to the hotel for leisure time.

Day 5 | Ggantija | Victoria | Xwejni Bay

Island of Gozo. Journey by ferry to this scenic island in the Maltese archipelago for a guided tour of another of Malta's megalithic gems, the Ggantija temple-complex, more than 5,500 years old and named for a fabled female giant. In Gozo's capital, Victoria, head up to the atmospheric, fortified Cittadella above the city for a guided stroll. Later, learn how a local

family uses centuries-old methods to collect, dry and store sea salt from a patchwork pattern of rock-cut salt pans along the shore of Xwejni Bay. Afterward, return by ferry to Malta.

Free Time: Your evening in Sliema is at leisure.

Day 6 | Embark ferry | Pozzallo, Italy | Piazza Armerina | Taormina

Check out this morning for the ferry to Sicily. After disembarking, enjoy a panoramic drive with views of Caltagirone in the Val di Noto on your route. Stop for lunch in Piazza Armerina.

Sicily's Mosaic Masterpieces. Study some of the most superb Roman mosaics in the world at Villa Romana del Casale, a UNESCO World Heritage site. This villa from the fourth century A.D. features more than 40 impeccably crafted floors with intricate scenes of heroes, hunting, circus games, female athletes and much more. Continue to Taormina and check in

to the Eurostars Monte Tauro.

Free Time: Find a nice spot for dinner in town.

Day 7 | Taormina

Taormina. Meander with your guide through this fashionable hillside resort town and see its medieval landmarks. Visit the famous Greek theater that offers stellar vistas of the Ionian Sea and majestic Mount Etna in the distance.

Connects | *Pizza Cooking Demo.* Get great tips for preparing authentic Sicilian pizza during a demonstration, then dig in for lunch!

Enrichment: *Sicilian Culture & Traditions.* Dine with your group tonight in Taormina.

Day 8 | Syracuse

Syracuse. Take in the Greek theater and the Roman amphitheater of this influential ancient Mediterranean city, then explore Latomia del Paradiso, a former limestone quarry, and the Ear of Dionysius, famed for its acoustics. After a stop to view Caravaggio's "The Burial of St. Lucy" at the Basilica Santa Lucia, walk along the picturesque lanes of Ortygia, Syracuse's island old town, a UNESCO World Heritage

site. Visit the baroque Cathedral of Syracuse in the Piazza del Duomo on your guided stroll.

Day 9 | Agrigento

After breakfast, depart for southwest Sicily.

Agrigento's Valley of the Temples. One of the most outstanding archaeological sites in the Mediterranean, the Valley is a showcase of the world's finest and best-preserved Greek temples. Be awed by the Doric temples of Concordia, Juno, Hercules and others on a tour of this UNESCO World Heritage site.

Day 10 | Taormina

Free Time: Choose to join today's Elective Activity or craft your own agenda in Taormina.

Elective | *Mount Etna*. Get an up-close look at Europe's largest active volcano! Walk along the Silvestri craters and see the lava fields at this UNESCO World Heritage site. Gather for a Farewell Reception and Dinner.


